Founded in 1990, ISHA is an organisation dedicated to encouraging international perspectives and increasing the international exchange of ideas among students of history and related academic disciplines.

The theme of volume 13 is taken from the 2011 Annual Conference of ISHA in Pula, Croatia: 'East and West: Bridging the Differences'. We welcome contributions that are related to this general theme or to one of the following specific topics, which correspond to the various conference workshops:

- Mythical Orient & Mental Perceptions of the East
- Interreligious Contacts
- Military and Political Confrontations
- Stereotypes and Mentalities
- Taboos
- Personas
- Scientific Contributions
- Popular Culture in the 20<sup>th</sup> Century
- Art
- Sports and Games
- Trade

*Guidelines for Contributions*

Articles will be accepted on the basis of a 1-to-2-page abstract, which should include a brief statement about the article's connection to the theme. The deadline for sending in an abstract is the 25<sup>th</sup> of April, 2011. Participants at the Annual Conference may also hand in their abstracts in person. Contributors will be informed by the 1<sup>st</sup> of May whether their abstracts have been accepted.

If your abstract is accepted you will receive a style sheet, which is intended primarily to ensure a unified citation system. Contributions should not exceed 15 single-spaced standard pages. The final deadline for submitting the articles will be the 1<sup>st</sup> of June.
